On the basis that that such a development on the Glebe field - if it goes ahead as displayed - will provide:

- A mix of 15 market homes - which will offer opportunity for South Stokers to upsize or downsize
- A mix of 10 “affordable” homes - which will offer people with “South Stoke Connections” who don’t presently have the means, the opportunity to come and live in the village
- A financial contribution - of £700,000 towards (less an amount for the existing tenant of up to £50,000) - for Village infrastructure development, i.e., a new Community Shop and a new Community Hall.
- A large green area, which would be handed over to the Parish Council and guaranteed to be kept development-free in perpetuity, and still be useable for car-parking for large village events.
- A screened parking area for users of the Recreation Ground, the Shop and Houses opposite on Cross Keys Road which presently have no off-street parking
- Bring new life into the village, which will help to ensure that it will maintain/renew all of its facilities
